Data Administrator	The data administrator is Digital Care sp. z o.o. with headquarters in Warsaw at Komitetu Obrony Robotników 48 (hereinafter „Digital Care”).

Data Protection Officer	A Data Protection Officer has been appointed in Digital Care. It is a person who can be contacted in all matters related to the processing of personal data and the use of rights related to data processing. The purposes of processing and the legal basis for processing	Your data will be processed in order to carry out the recruitment process currently or in the future by Digital Care - the basis for data processing are labor law and your consent to the processing of personal data.
Recipients of data	Digital Care will transfer your personal data to data processors in the field of recruitment or services related to the provision of IT systems for recruitment purposes, which will process your personal data on the basis of a contract and only on behalf of Digital Care. Digital Care will pass your personal data to these entities only for your consent. Your data will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area (EEA).
The period of data storage	Digital Care will store your personal data until the end of the recruitment process or until you withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data. If you consent to the processing of personal data for the purposes of future recruitment processes, Digital Care will store your personal data for two years from the last update of your personal data or until you withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data.
The rights of the data subject	You have the right to access your data and the right to demand their rectification, removal or restriction of their processing.

	<p>You have the right to withdraw your consent. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing that was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.</p> <p>To the extent that your data is processed in an automated manner on the basis of consent - you also have the right to transfer your personal data, i.e. to receive personal data from the administrator, in a structured, commonly used format suitable for machine reading. You may send this data to another data administrator.</p> <p>You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body dealing with the protection of personal data.</p> <p>In order to exercise these rights, please contact Digital Care or the Data Protection Officer.
